PETITIONER'S ANSWER TO RESPONDENT'S COUNTER PETITION

Comes now Angela Sarah Vaca, Petitioner, and for her Answer to Respondent's Counter
Petition states and alleges as follows:

1. Petitioner admits the contents of Paragraphs 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 18, and 19.
2. Petitioner denies that it is in the best interest of the child for the Respondent to exercise joint custody with Petitioner of the minor children of the marriage. Petitioner should be awarded custody of the minor children with Respondent granted visitation.
3. There is no free child care available to either party. Child care costs for the two children total \$600.00 per month; this is a very reasonable amount for the care of two children. Petitioner will stipulate that she will maintain the health insurance on the children that she has maintained throughout the parties' long separation. Mr. Vaca should be ordered to pay his proportionate share of that cost.
4. Right of first refusal is not in the best interest of the children at this time. Respondent, until recently forced to by Petitioner, was unwilling and unable to care for the minor children simultaneously. Respondent lacks the maturity and parenting skills necessary to provide for the best interest and welfare of the children if a right of first refusal were ordered.
