**PETITIONER'S ANSWER TO RESPONDENT'S COUNTER-APPLICATION FOR  
TEMPORARY ORDER AND COUNTERCLAIM**

Comes now Angela Sarah Vaca, Petitioner, and for her Answer to Respondent's Counter Application for Temporary Order states and alleges as follows:

1. Petitioner admits the contents of Paragraphs 4 and 5 of the Respondent's Counter Application.
2. The relationship between the parties to this matter mitigate *against* the entry of a joint custody plan. Petitioner has been the care giver for the minor children of the marriage and has made all child rearing decisions on behalf of the children during the separation of the parties. During the term of the parties' long separation Mr. Vaca has demonstrated an unwillingness to cooperate with the petitioner in the best interest of the children. Since the filing of this action the Respondent has been uncooperative with the petitioner in assuring the best interest of the children is the priority of the parties and has subjected the respondent to derision and abusive name-calling. Joint custody is not in the best interest of the minor children and should not be the temporary order of this court.
3. Petitioner agrees that support should be entered in accord with the Child Support Guidelines; however, Petitioner does not believe that Respondent should be granted visitation sufficient to allow for an offset to his obligation.
